CABLE SANDS, USE OF ROUNDUP BIOACTIVE

145. Hon Jim Scott to the Minister for Housing and Works representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

Further to question on notice No. 12 of August 13 2002 -

How much Roundup Bioactive has Cable Sands used since beginning its revegetation program at -

- (a) the State Forest section; and
- (b) the excised portion of the D'Entrecasteaux National Park?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

- (a) Cable Sands has advised it has used less than 500mL of Roundup Bioactive on the State Forest to control local weed outbreaks as per the rehabilitation plan. This has been applied by using a backpack-type sprayer.
- (b) Cable Sands have not used Roundup Bioactive in the excised portion of the D'Entrecasteaux National Park.
