

RAIL LINES — DISRUPTION — JOONDALUP AND MANDURAH

3310. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the train disruptions to the Joondalup and Mandurah rail line on 24 June 2015, and I ask:

- (a) what time did the delays first occur;
- (b) what were the technical issues responsible;
- (c) when did services resume; and
- (d) how many services were affected?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) 2:16pm
- (b) There was a points failure at Butler and the Public Transport Authority's Train Control could not move the points remotely.
- (c) No services ceased.
- (d) 28 services were affected.
