### ENVIRONMENT — DRAFT FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN 2014–2023

## 1006. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*, prepared by the Conservation Commission, through the former Department of Environment and Conservation, and ask:

- (a) did the Conservation Commission employ consultants to submit advice on the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*, and if yes, what are the names of the consulting firms/agents; and
- (b) if applicable, what were the terms of reference, period of engagement and payment to each individual consultant/consultancy group?

# Mr A.P. Jacob replied:

- (a) Yes. The following consultants were engaged to advise or contribute to the development of the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*:
  - Astron Environmental Services
  - Gaia Resources
  - Joanna Young & Associates
  - Resolve Global
  - Tony Brandis Environmental Consultancy
  - Tuna Blue Pty Ltd
  - URS Australia Pty Ltd
- (b) Astron Environmental Services was engaged to provide advice on options for future key performance indicators in the areas of biodiversity and ecosystem health and vitality.

Period of engagement: August to October 2012

Consultancy fee: \$18 598

Gaia Resources was engaged to "Quantify some of the values and threats within the various Land Management Units across the forested area of the south-west of Western Australia and compare them against one another. This includes assessing the presence and prevalence of values and threats on aspects such as biodiversity, heritage, social use and resource use (such as forest production)".
