## STATE BUDGET 2013-14 — ROAD FUNDING

## 553. Mr M.P. MURRAY to the Minister for Transport:

I have a supplementary question. Having said that, does the minister stand by his comments and make it very clear for *Hansard* that if the commonwealth withdraws its funding, it is highly unlikely that these roads will go ahead; or is it just going to be another broken promise?

## Mr T.R. BUSWELL replied:

I just said —

Mr M.P. Murray: I heard you! I just want you to confirm it.

Mr T.R. BUSWELL: I said it about a second ago!

Mr M.P. Murray: But we can't believe what you say once; you've got to say it three or four times.

The SPEAKER: Member for Collie-Preston!

**Mr T.R. BUSWELL**: The good news for the member for Collie–Preston is that the \$50 million-plus to upgrade the Collie coalfields highway is happening. A big chunk of it is being spent —

**Mr M.P. Murray**: I'm not asking about that.

**Mr T.R. BUSWELL**: A big chunk of it will be spent. That is the road to the member's home town that he has never asked a question on in Parliament in eight years, just for his information.

Mr M.P. Murray interjected.

The SPEAKER: Member for Collie-Preston!

**Mr T.R. BUSWELL**: It is a very simple equation: if the commonwealth does not provide that funding, it is highly unlikely that those road projects will go ahead. If the commonwealth does not —

Mr M.P. Murray: Sit down—you've answered the question.

Mr T.R. BUSWELL: If the commonwealth does not provide the funding —

Mr M.P. Murray: No, no! I don't want anymore.

**The SPEAKER**: Member for Collie–Preston, unfortunately, you are not in charge of proceedings here. Minister, have you finished?

**Mr T.R. BUSWELL**: I was nearly finished, Mr Speaker, but I was interrupted by the member for Collie–Preston. I was just going to say that if the commonwealth does not provide that funding, I will write to every Western Australian federal member of Parliament and arrange a bus to drive them from Perth to Port Hedland and from Port Hedland to Perth via Great Northern Highway and North West Coastal Highway.

Mr T.R. BUSWELL: I will give members a tip. There will be a raffle —
