902. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Transport representing the Minister for Local Government:

I refer to question without notice 483 asked in the Legislative Assembly on November 23 1999 and ask -

- (1) Does the need to ensure that land actually receives a service also apply to land that is not vacant?
- (2) What measures does the Department of Local Government require from local government authorities to show that vacant and non-vacant land is actually receiving a service from security patrols?

Hon M.J. CRIDDLE replied:

- (1) Section 6.38 of the Local Government Act does not specify such a requirement. It is discretionary on a local government whether it applies a service charge to all land or excludes certain types of land.
- (2) None. This is a matter for each local government to determine.
