REID HIGHWAY EXTENSION - METROPOLITAN REGION SCHEME AMENDMENT

319. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the Minister for Transport:

Main Roads WA has begun work on the Reid Highway extension past Lake Carine in areas outside the road reservation.

- (1) Is this area subject to a planning amendment that is before Parliament?
- (2) Why is the work being done before the amendment has been passed by the Parliament?
- What will be the effect on these roadworks if the metropolitan region scheme amendment is disallowed in Parliament?
- (4) Has Main Roads received advice on its action; and if so, will the minister provide details or table that advice?

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) Yes
- (2) Main Roads has obtained valid planning approval from the Western Australian Planning Commission for the project.
