

WIRELESS HILL PARK, LAND EXCISION

1171. Hon JIM SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

With regard to the proposed excision of Wireless Hill Reserve A28913 -

- (1) Who currently has ownership of the reserve?
- (2) Who currently manages the reserve?
