2726. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the trial shipment at Albany Port by Vicstock Grain, and I ask:

- (a) how many tonnes of grain per annum are expected to be exported by Vicstock;
- (b) does the Government know how this grain is being, or will be, transported to Albany Port;
- (c) if yes to (b), how much will be transported to port by:
 - (i) road; and
 - (ii) rail; and
- (d) if no to (b), why not?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) Vicstock Grain has stated they hope to export up to 250 000 tonnes per annum. This annual production would be ramped up over several years.
