

ROADS — MARGARET RIVER PERIMETER ROAD — PROJECT STATUS

4248. Hon Adele Farina to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) What is the current status of the Margaret River Perimeter Road?
- (2) How much funding has been spent on the project to date?
- (3) How much funding was spent on the project in 2015–16 and what works were completed?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (1) Stage 1 from Rosa Brook Road to Bussell Highway South was completed in May 2015.
Stage 2 from the northern roundabout connection to Rosa Brook Road which includes a road bridge and a foot bridge over the Margaret River and 2.2 km of John Archibald Drive is being prepared for tender in early 2017 with completion due in April 2018.
- (2) \$20.94 million.
- (3) \$6.2 million. The following works were completed:
 - Geotechnical Investigations
 - Land purchases and advanced payments
 - Telstra service relocations
 - Western Power relocations
 - Preliminary road design
 - Concept foot bridge design
 - Clearing and mulching
 - Environmental offset payment
 - Fencing
