HAMELIN BAY ACCESS ROAD AND BOAT RAMP, ALTERATIONS

- 544. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for the Environment and Heritage
- (1) Will the Minister advise what alterations can take place to the Hamelin Bay access road and boat ramp?
- (2) Will the boat ramp continue to be available to the general public?

Dr J.M. EDWARDS replied:

- (1) It is proposed to realign the Hamelin Bay access road to pass around the north side of the Hamelin Bay caravan park and connect with the public car park and boat ramp access at the beach. The proposed new road will remove the congestion and traffic hazards associated with the current route through the caravan park. The public facilities at the beach have been improved with better car parking and new toilets.
- (2) Yes, the boat ramp will continue to be available to the public.
