2908. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Minister's announcement on *Nine Morning News* of \$56 million towards cycling, and I ask:

- (a) where in the budget papers can the \$56 million be found;
- (b) what specific projects will the \$56 million fund; and
- (c) from what funding programs will the \$56 million be sourced?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) Pages 805 and 817.
- (b) Cycling infrastructure as part of the Gateway WA project, Principal Shared Path projects on the Midland Line (Success Hill to Midland section) and the Fremantle Line (Shenton Park to Lock Street), and the annual local government grants program.
- (c) The appropriations for the Gateway WA project, the Western Australian Bicycle Network Plan, the Strategic Transport Policy and Integrated Planning program and the Perth Parking Management Account.
