316. Dr GALLOP to the Minister for Citizenship and Multicultural Interests:

Does the minister acknowledge that One Nation's policies on multiculturalism and anti-racism are in direct contradiction to his Government's policies?

Mr JOHNSON replied:

I have not seen One Nation's policies.

Dr Gallop: Where have you been for the past three years? You are supposed to be the minister responsible for this issue!

Mr JOHNSON: If the leader is referring to One Nation's policies from years gone by, I have forgotten them.

Dr Gallop: Have they changed?

Mr JOHNSON: I do not know. If the leader has seen the party's latest policies, that is fine. The Government is interested only in its policies, which are very positive, anti-discriminatory and anti-racist.
