## NORTHBRIDGE CURFEW - STATUS OF CHILDREN REMOVED FROM AREA BY POLICE

- 2160. Mr P.D. Omodei to the Minister for Police and Emergency Services
- (1) How many of the children removed from Northbridge via the curfew in the following years were wards of the State -
  - (a) 2004-2005;
  - (b) 2005-2006; and
  - (c) 2006/2007 (year to date)?
- (2) How many of those wards of the State, that were removed via the curfew, were absent without leave from their foster or hostel care?

## Mr J.C. KOBELKE replied:

- (1) The report on the Young People in Northbridge Policy "The Policy Three Years On 2003 2006" included the following figures showing total number of young people removed from Northbridge via the curfew:
  - (a) 2004 2005 751
  - (b) 2005 2006 634
