## LAKE KEPWARI — PREMIER COAL SITE

1931. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Mines and Petroleum:

I refer to the Lake Kepwari mine void on Yancoal Australia Group's Premier Coal mine site in Collie, and ask:

- (a) is the Lake Kepwari mine void currently being used as a diving training venue;
- (b) how was the availability to use the Lake Kepwari mine void allocated to the current company using the facility as a training site; and
- (c) does the Department of Mines and Petroleum have any control over how mine voids are used, the purpose of their use and who accesses the mine voids for such purposes?

## Mr W.R. Marmion replied:

The Department of Mines and Petroleum advises:

- (a)–(b) This question should be referred to the Minister for Environment.
- (c) The Department of Mines and Petroleum has statutory input into approvals, operations, safety, and mine closure that relate to mine voids subject to the provisions contained within the *Mines Safety and Inspection Act 1994*, *Mines Safety and Inspection Regulations 1995* and *Mining Act 1978* and *Mining Regulations 1981*.
