- (5) As at 28 April 2016 the Southern Ports Authority (SPA) has spent \$3 914 036.95 funded jointly by SPA and Royalties for Regions.
- (6) SPA has budgeted a further \$372 259.78. Total cost depends on whether further work is required once stakeholder requirements are known.
