## 312. Hon JIM SCOTT to the minister representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage:

(1) Have any soil excavations been carried out at the Midland railway workshop site? If so, please provide details of the locations and contaminant levels.

- (2) What is the nature of the large stockpiles of soil situated at the eastern end of the site, and from where have they come?
- (3) What air monitoring has been undertaken at the Midland railway workshop site and what are the results?
- (4) Has any monitoring been undertaken for airborne asbestos at the Midland railway workshop site; and, if so, what are the results?
