998. Mr R.S. Love to the Minister for Environment:

Can the Government categorically rule out the \$85 per tonne Waste Levy which will be paid by Metropolitan and Peel local governments from July 1 2024, will not be extended to regional local governments in the future?

Mr R.R. Whitby replied:

A review of the waste levy, released in May 2023, noted arguments for and against applying a levy to areas outside of the current Perth metropolitan region boundary. Any consideration of options to expand the boundary of the waste levy would require public consultation as part of a regulatory impact assessment process.
