GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES, ARTWORKS

- 653. Hon Ljiljanna Ravlich to the Minister for Transport representing the Minister for Works:
- (1) Will the Minister for Works detail for all the departments, agencies, statutory authorities and corporatised entities under his control -
 - (a) the value of all artworks, which includes painting, ceramics and glassware;
 - (b) who funded the purchase of the artworks; and
 - (c) who owns the artworks?
