

BUTLER TRAIN STATION — CAMERAS

3388. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the cameras facing the entrances and exits of the car parks at the Butler Train Station, and ask:

- (a) what is the purpose of the cameras;
- (b) on what date were the cameras installed;
- (c) how was the installer of the cameras selected;
- (d) on what date was the project for the installation of these cameras advertised or quotes requested;
- (e) on what date was the contract awarded;
- (f) how much funding was allocated for their installation; and
- (g) when were funds allocated for their installation?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) For security purposes.
- (b) The cameras were installed during the construction of Butler station and were commissioned for the opening of the station in September 2014.
- (c) The installer was included in part of the station contract which was selected from an open tender process.
- (d) Refer to part (c).
- (e) 22 May 2012.
- (f) The funding for the cameras was part of the station contract.
- (g) On 16 November 2009 as part of Cabinet approval to extend the northern rail line to Butler at a capital cost of \$240.73 million.
