RAIL TRANSPORT — AUSTRALIND MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

1961. Hon Adele Farina to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Australiad train, and I ask:

- (a) will the Minister table the current maintenance contract for the Australind train;
- (b) if no to (a), why not; and
- (c) what is the current maintenance program for the *Australind* train?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a)–(b) There is no *Australind* maintenance contract. The maintenance for the *Australind* is carried out by the Public Transport Authority.
- (c) The current maintenance regime details are:
 - (i) Trip service basic checks of fuel, coolant and oil levels coupled with a visual inspection of the car and a check of the fault log book;
 - (ii) Weekly service as above, plus functional checks of the railcar safety systems and the issue of a Certificate of Roadworthiness;
 - (iii) A service undertaken monthly;
 - (iv) B service undertaken four monthly;
 - (v) C service undertaken eight monthly;
 - (vi) D service undertaken sixteen monthly;
 - (vii) Wheel-sets are re-profiled every 12–18 months; and
 - (viii) Overhauls to heavy component (i.e. engines, transmission and bogies) are undertaken approximately every 7 years.
