Mr P.D. Omodei presented the following petition bearing the signatures of 69 persons -

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

Manjimup Town - Co-location of Emergency Services

We the undersigned are concerned that the proposal for a co-located Fire Brigade and State Emergency Services building is still not being progressed in Manjimup. This project has been under consideration for many years and we find it unacceptable that the State Government should still be deliberating over the matter.

The proposal for a new co-located building for emergency services would be timely as the community is suffering as a result of Government policy decisions on Forests.

We now ask that the Legislative Assembly advise the Minister for Police and Emergency Services and the Fire and Emergency Services authority of our genuine concerns about delays and the need for an appropriate facility and we call on the State Government to allocate appropriate funding for this project to be completed as soon as possible.
