

SHALE ROAD CLASS 3 LANDFILL, CARDUP, LICENCE CONDITIONS

137. Hon Jim Scott to the Minister for Housing and Works representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage
- (1) Will the Minister table the licence conditions for the Shale Road Class 3 Landfill in Cardup?
 - (2) Does the DEP require bore monitoring test results as a condition of licence for the Shale Road Class 3 Landfill in Cardup?
 - (3) If yes, will the Minister table the results of the monitoring bore tests for the last two years?
 - (4) Has the DEP been provided with test results for contaminants in the leachate from the Shale Road Class 3 Landfill in Cardup?
 - (5) If yes, will the Minister please detail those results?
 - (6) Has leachate from the Shale Road Class 3 Landfill in Cardup been used in any ASLP (leachate tests) commissioned by the DEP?
 - (7) If yes, will the Minister provide details?

- 1) Yes. I now table the licence conditions for the Shale Road Class 3 Landfill. [See paper No 345.]

- 3) I now table the results of bore monitoring for the past two years. [See paper No 345.]
