## ESPERANCE PORT AUTHORITY BOARD, MS MEGAN ANWYL

## 1158. Mr R.F. Johnson to the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

I refer to the appointment of former Labor member Megan Anwyl to the Esperance Port Authority Board, and ask –

- (a) under what terms has Ms Anwyl been employed;
- (b) what qualifications did Ms Anwyl display to secure this position;
- (c) what is Ms Anwyl's salary in this position;
- (d) what are the salaries of other Board members;
- (e) what expenses will Ms Anwyl be entitled to;
- (f) will a tax-payer funded car be allocated to Ms Anwyl; and
- (g) what hours will Ms Anwyl be required to work?

## Ms A.J. MacTIERNAN replied:

- (a) Ms Anwyl is not employed by the Esperance Port Authority.
- (b) Ms Anwyl is a lawyer with, as former Member for Kalgoorlie, considerable knowledge of the region, industries and communities serviced by the Esperance Port Authority.
- (c) Regional Port Authority Board Members are paid \$8,100 per annum.
- (d) Regional Port Authority Board Members are paid \$8,100 per annum. Regional Port Authority Chairpersons are paid \$16,200 per annum.
- (e) Board Members' travel expenses are paid for attendance at board meetings. Accommodation and meals are also provided if required to stay overnight.
- (f) No
- (g) Esperance Port Authority has monthly Board meetings of approximately 4-5 hours duration. Board Members also attend workshops and other meetings when required.
