- 102. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure In relation to the Review of the Kwinana Air Quality Buffer -
- (1) What air pollutants were taken into consideration when formulating the new buffer zones?
- (2) Will the Minister detail -
 - (a) what industries were taken into consideration when developing the new buffer zones; and
 - (b) what were the air pollutants considered from each of these industries?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

- (1) The review of the Kwinana air quality buffer utilised existing available information on constraints from land uses including sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxides, dust and odour.
- (2) (a)-(b) Kwinana Industrial Area sulphur dioxide, nitrogen oxides and dust. Woodman Point and Kwinana wastewater treatment plants odour. Alcoa residue storage area dust.

Cockburn Cement – sulphur dioxide and dust.

Henderson landfill – odour and dust.

Basic raw material areas – dust.
