How many people were subjected to an ambulance bypass in the Western Australian public health system in 2007 to date (provide details of numbers and hospitals)?

Mr J.A. McGINTY replied:

Data about the number of people subjected to an ambulance bypass is not recorded and therefore cannot be provided. Once a hospital goes on diversion, ambulance traffic is automatically diverted. Ambulance diversion is recorded in the number of hours diversion per month per hospital.
