

BICYCLE NETWORK PLAN — NARROWS TO MOUNT HENRY BRIDGES LINK

1827. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Western Australia Bicycle Network Plan and ask, for the priority link alongside the Kwinana Freeway from the Narrows Bridge to the Mount Henry Bridge:

- (a) what planning work has been done on this link;
- (b) what are the details of the works required;
- (c) when does the Minister expect work to commence;
- (d) when does the Minister expect works to be completed;
- (e) what is the estimated cost of this project; and
- (f) how much is currently allocated in the 2014–15 State Budget and in each year of the forward estimates?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a)–(b) The existing path is proposed to be upgraded to improve sight lines. A high level upgrade assessment has been undertaken.
- (c)–(d) A path upgrade has recently been completed. No further widening works are planned within the current forward estimates.
- (e) Works to date are \$3.47 million. The cost estimate for remaining works will be developed after the design has been completed.
- (f) Nil for this section of the Kwinana Freeway.
