- (1) The development is on time and within budget.
- (2) It is envisaged that most lots will be leased. Marketing of the facility and its capabilities has commenced.
- (3) Negotiations with potential clients are continuing.
- (4) The facility is in competition with other locations for repair and maintenance of all vessels.
