- (1) How much of the \$144.662 million was provided by —
 - (a) the commonwealth government;
 - (b) Brookfield Rail to meet obligations under its contract; and
 - (c) the state government?
- (2) Where will the remaining \$18.924 million be spent?
- (3) What other sections of tier 1 or 2 lines have had none of the \$144.662 million spent on them, and why?
