

SHARED USE BICYCLE PATH, EAST PERTH-MAYLANDS

46. Hon MURRAY CRIDDLE to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

I refer to the shared use bicycle path currently being constructed adjacent to the Perth-Midland railway between the Graham Farmer Freeway and Caledonian Avenue in Maylands.

- (1) What is the estimated cost of the path?
- (2) What will be the length of the path?
- (3) What will be the width of the path?
- (4) What was the commencement date of that work and when will it be completed?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The estimated cost of the dual pedestrian and cycle path is \$2.8 million.
- (2) The path will be three kilometres in length and will involve substantial work on embankments.
- (3) The path's width will be three metres, with half metre side clearances.
- (4) Construction of the shared use path commenced on 30 January 2002 and the anticipated completion date is 31 October 2002.
