

PUBLIC TRANSPORT — FERRY SERVICE

867. Mr R.S. Love to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Department of Transport's report into 'Perth's Ferry Services – Current Status and Future Use' report, and I ask:

- (a) Is an expanded ferry system still being actively considered by the Government;
- (b) If so, please detail the routes being considered by the Government; and
- (c) Does the Government have plans to commission another report into an expanded ferry system?

Ms R. Saffioti replied:

(a)–(c) Our Government is always considering ways to improve our public transport system.

That's why we're investing in METRONET, the biggest expansion to our public transport system in our state's history.

That's also why we've capped fares at the cost of a two-zone fare, saving commuters up to \$2,900 per year.
