

CANE TOADS

95. Hon JIM CHOWN to the Minister for Environment:

- (1) Does the government have a plan in place to slow or control the southern movement of the cane toad?
- (2) If yes to (1), what does that plan entail?

Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)-(2) Yes. To manage the southern movement of cane toads, the “Cane toad strategy for Western Australia 2014-2019” provides direction on quarantine efforts and preventing hitchhikers from colonising ahead of the cane toad frontline. For the member’s information, I table a copy of that report.
