I refer to DPI tender number 1022-06 and ask -

- (1) How many different brochures were typeset for the \$125,641.26 paid to Advance Press?
- (2) How many tender applications were received for this tender?
- (3) Who was the least expensive tenderer and what was the total amount of that tender?
- (4) Who was the most expensive tenderer and what was the total amount of that tender?

Ms A.J.G. MacTIERNAN replied:

- (1) The tender was called for the typesetting of an estimated total of 1050 different pocket public transport timetables over a period of 3 years. \$125,641.26 is the estimated maximum expenditure based on initial set up costs then hourly rates and estimated times to prepare 8, 10 and 12 panel timetable typesets. No payment has been made to Advance Press to date.

- (3) DataNZ Ltd submitted the least expensive tender estimated at \$54,808.62 based on initial set up costs then hourly rates and estimated times to prepare 8, 10 and 12 panel timetable typesets. DataNZ however failed to demonstrate suitable experience or quality control mechanisms associated with providing timetable typesets from India.
- (4) Worldwide Online Printing O'Connor submitted the most expensive tender estimated at \$140,763.03 based on initial set up costs then hourly rates and estimated times to prepare 8, 10 and 12 panel timetable typesets.
