

BEELIAR REGIONAL PARK, FREMANTLE-ROCKINGHAM HIGHWAY RESERVATION AT MT
BROWN

410. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
- (1) Is the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure aware that the Beeliar Regional Park Draft Management Plan of November 2001 proposes that the Fremantle-Rockingham Highway reservation through the Mount Brown section be incorporated into the Beeliar Regional Park?
- (2) Is the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure aware that the rezoning of this road reservation to parks and recreation was proposed back in 1998?
- (3) Is the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure aware that in May 2000, the then Minister for Transport stated in Parliament that Main Roads would request the Western Australian Planning Commission to initiate an amendment to the MRS for the removal of the road reservation in the latter half of 2000?
- (4) Has this been done?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

- (1)-(4) Yes. The removal of this section of road has been proposed in several planning documents. The Department for Planning and Infrastructure anticipates to present a report to the April meeting of the Perth Regional Planning Committee of the Western Australian Planning Commission to formally initiate this Metropolitan Region Scheme amendment.
