

EAST PERTH POWER STATION, REDEVELOPMENT

269. Hon Jim Scott to the Minister for Housing and Works representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

(1) Can the Minister confirm that the East Perth Power Station will be conserved in a way that its heritage values will be retained?

(2) Who will be responsible for carrying out work to refurbish and redevelop the East Perth Power Station?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

1. The conservation and redevelopment of the East Perth Power Station is currently subject to review by a Ministerial Committee. As the place is on the Register of Heritage Places any development will require the approval of the Heritage Council of Western Australia, who will consider any proposal in the context of the conservation plan for the place.

2. The responsibility for refurbishment and redevelopment of the Power Station is yet to be determined.
