PERENJORI POLICE STATION, REDUCTION IN SERVICES

- 842. Hon M.J. CRIDDLE to the minister representing the Minister for Police and Emergency Services:
- (1) Will there be a reduction in police services in Perenjori?
- (2) If so, does this mean the local police station will close?
- (3) Which other towns will be affected by this practice?
- (4) Did the minister consult with the community before this decision was made?

Hon N.D. GRIFFITHS replied:

- (1) The Western Australia Police Service advises that the current staffing levels and the WAPS operational needs of the Perenjori Police Station and a number of police establishments are being examined.
- (2) To date, no decision has been made on the future of the Perenjori Police Station.
- (3) Policing levels in all towns are monitored.
- (4) No decision has been made by the minister.
