

ROAD FUNDING SOURCES

625. Hon M.J. CRIDDLE to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

Given the minister's response to my question on Wednesday, 19 September 2001, what are the total road funding sources other than vehicle charges identified in the 2001-02 budget?

Hon G.T. GIFFARD replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

Total road funding sources other than vehicle licence fees for 2001-02 are as follows -

Commonwealth funds, \$106.835 million;

Internal funds and balances, \$9.3 million;

DPI - high wide loads - \$14.5 million;

DPI - Perth bike plan stage 2 - \$5 million;

Debtors - works undertaken on behalf of others, \$16.645 million;

Borrowings - \$69.15 million;

Overload/oversize permits \$1.6 million;

Consolidated fund, item 82, \$226.347 million, which includes funding for depreciation amounting to \$118.02 million.

Consolidated fund, item 166, \$142.863 million.

The total is \$592.24 million dollars.
