- (1) Can the Attorney General please advise whether convicted paedophile Paul Thompson has been added to the ANCOR register -
 - (a) if so, when did this occur; or
 - (b) if not, why not?
- (2) Is there currently an alert in place within the Department for Community Development in regards to Mr Thompson to ensure that there is not a repeat of the incident in which a young boy was allegedly abused by his piano teacher?

Mr J.A. McGINTY replied:

ANCOR started operation after the Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Act 2004 was proclaimed. ANCOR is monitored and managed by the Police.

Question (1) may be more appropriately directed to the Minister for Police, and question (2) to the Minister for Community Development.
