## 505. Dr GALLOP to the Minister for Works; Services; Citizenship and Multicultural Interests:

Will the Minister provide the following details for all Government owned assets sold since January 1997 which had a sale value of \$500,000 or more -

- (a) name and nature of the asset;
- (b) date sold;
- (c) nature of sale and name of buyer;
- (d) proceeds received from the asset;
- (e) associated revenue from the sale, such as stamp duty;
- (f) the application of the funds received; and
- (g) any associated costs incurred in the sale process?

- (f) Proceeds retained by Western Australian Building Management Authority.
- (g) Marketing and sale costs of \$34,000 approximately.

#### STATE SUPPLY COMMISSION

- (a) Sale of Supply West "One Stop Shop" for bulk purchasing, warehousing and distribution of goods to public sector agencies.
- (b) 6 September 1999
- (c) Tender National Office Products Ltd, trading as Boise Cascade Office Products
- (d) \$4.7820 million
- (e) Not aware of any associated revenue
- (f) Paid to Consolidated Funds (Treasury)
- (g) Approximately \$478,841 was incurred in the sale process. This comprises of \$477,365 from the Department of Contract and Management Services and \$1,476 from the Commission.
