- (1) The annual cost is \$471,226.
- (2) There are 50 fortnightly insertions booked with the Community Newspaper Group over a period of two years.
- (3) The number of different editions produced varies each fortnight. On average, seven different versions are produced each fortnight. Six different templates (variations in layout) have been produced.
