## 475. Hon JIM SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for State Development:

My question relates to the Wagerup alumina refinery.

- (1) On what date was the Department of Mines first informed of employee concerns about emissions from the liquor burner?
- (2) How and by who was the department informed?
- When did the inspector of mines first take action on this matter, and when did he first request Alcoa to investigate and take action on the concerns?
- (4) Will the minister table a copy of the inspector's initial request of Alcoa and any other correspondence regarding liquor burner emissions during 1996 and 1997 between the department and Alcoa; and, if not, why not?
