

BUS SAFETY AND SECURITY PATROL VEHICLES — BUNBURY

4094. Hon Adele Farina to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) How many buses in Bunbury, for each category of school bus, town bus and those used for both route types, are currently fitted with:
  - (a) CCTV cameras; and
  - (b) driver cages?
- (2) In each of the years 2015 and 2016 to date, how many security patrol vehicles:
  - (a) have operated in Bunbury;
  - (b) on what dates; and
  - (c) for each patrol, for how many hours?

**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

Insofar as the Public Transport Authority is concerned as at 28 April 2016:

- (1) (a)–(b) The Bunbury fleet comprises of 36 buses in total. Of these, 18 buses are fitted with both CCTV and driver cages and 11 buses are fitted with CCTV only. Buses can be used on either school routes or town bus routes, noting that the 18 buses fitted with both CCTV and driver cages are primarily targeted for use on town bus routes.
