- (1) Will the Minister please table the most recent inventory for the Brookdale Liquid Waste Treatment Facility?
  - (2) If not, why not?
  - (3) Will the Minister table the most recent Site Inspection report it has for the Brookdale Liquid Waste Treatment Facility?
  - (4) If not, why not?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

The Minister for the Environment has provided the following response:

- (1) Yes, I now seek leave to table the most recent inventory for the Brookdale Liquid Waste Treatment Facility (Attachment 1). [See paper No 1303.]

- (3) Yes, I now seek leave to table a copy of the latest Environmental Protection Authority site audit report, dated 20 February 2003 (Attachment 2). In addition to Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) site audits, Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) inspectors regularly visit the site to ensure waste acceptance and general operating requirements are being met. As the DEP is not the regulator for this facility, these visits are not compiled into formal site inspection reports.
