- (9) Projects may be considered for Safer Roads funding under the Target Crash Safer Roads or Community Safer Roads categories. Community Safer Roads Projects are those where the Government gives priority to addressing the concerns of the community about safety issues on a road. Community Safer Roads Projects are assessed on a Road Safety Triple Bottom Line approach. The criterion for the Safer Bridges component of the program is based on progressing improvements to a priority listing of routes or part routes determined by Main Roads which have substandard structures to improve freight efficiency.
