

**DWELLINGUP DISCOVERY FOREST AREA**

*Petition*

**MRS R.M.J. CLARKE (Murray–Wellington)** [12.01 pm]: I have a petition that has been certified by the Clerk from 1 135 petitioners in the following terms. I also have a number of nonconforming pages on the same issue, the total of those signatures being 674. The petition reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

<b>We the undersigned say</b>	Mining is planned around all sides of Dwellingup, including close to town, Destroying or impacting Camp grounds, walking, cycling and carriage tracks, Protected Fauna zones, ( Quokka ) High value Jarrah forest, existing educational and scientific research areas, and water resources.
<b>Now we ask the Legislative Assembly</b>	We, the undersigned, are concerned citizens who urge our leaders to act now to Protect DWELLINGUP and its surrounds, by the creation of a Discovery forest area ( MINING EXCLUSION ZONE )
