- (2) 5 February 2011, 10 August 2013 and 14 September 2013.
- (3) 70 to 80 years old, 60 to 80 years old, and 23 years old.
- (4) 2009, 2011, and 2012.
- (5) Natural disasters and vehicles illegally exceeding the posted load limit.
- (6) None.
