

“PUBLIC TRANSPORT FOR PERTH IN 2031” PLAN — PERTH AIRPORT

771. Hon Ken Travers to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the passenger modelling used in developing the draft “Public Transport for Perth in 2031” plan, and I ask:

- (a) what was the level of daily employment at Perth Airport used for the 2008 base case;
- (b) what was the level of daily employment at Perth Airport used for the 2031 preferred scenario;
- (c) what was the estimated daily number of passengers who would use the Perth Airport rail line in 2031;
- (d) how many of the people in would be people who work at Perth Airport; and
- (e) how many people were estimated to live in the suburbs to the east of the airport?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a)–(e) The Public Transport for Perth in 2031 Plan is nearing finalisation for consideration by Government. Until that consideration is complete, it is premature to provide estimates.
