Will the Minister provide details of all contracts undertaken by the Minister's office since 1 January 2004 that were outside the scope of the whole of Government common use contracts, including but not limited to -

- (a) the purpose of the contract; and
- (b) the cost of the contract?

Mr E.S. RIPPER replied:

The staff resources required to collate a response to the Members broad question about "all contracts" cannot be justified as all minor purchases, such as publications, constitute a contract and they would need to be included in responding.

However, if the member has a specific query I will endeavour to provide a response.
