

RAIL LINES — DISRUPTION — JOONDALUP AND MANDURAH

2206. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the train disruption to the Mandurah and Joondalup rail lines on 12 November 2014, and I ask:

- (a) what time did the delays first occur;
- (b) what were the technical issues responsible;
- (c) when did services resume; and
- (d) how many services were affected?

**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

- (a) 3.53pm.
- (b) Railcar failed.
- (c) Services were running continuously on the Mandurah to Joondalup line during the disruption albeit those services were delayed. Services resumed according to the timetable at 8.00pm.
- (d) 107 services were delayed, two services were cancelled and two trains did not complete their full journey.
