**586. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the two existing rail stow lines at the Claisebrook depot in precinct 16B.

- (1) What approval or exemption does the Public Transport Authority have for these lines?
- (2) When did it receive the approval or exemption for these lines?
- (3) Who provided the approval or exemption?
- (4) How much has been spent on replacing wooden sleepers on these lines in the last two years?
