TIMBER INDUSTRY, VOLUMES

730. Mr BARNETT to Premier:

I have a supplementary question. Is the reason for the continued delay in announcing the timber volumes related to the Government's decision to defer the \$12 million forestry assistance package, given that timber workers cannot apply for funding assistance until they have certainty about the volume of resource allocation?

Dr GALLOP replied:

The answer is clear, and it is no.
